

Pharmacy Technician

Workforce Development: Lifelong Learning

This program is designed to train students for a career as a Pharmacy Technician in hospitals or community pharmacies. The Pharmacy Technician Program provides students with the skills and knowledge to work in the Pharmacy environment. Pharmacy technicians work under the direction of a Pharmacist to measure, mix, count out, label and record amounts and dosages of medications based on the prescription orders as well as provide customer service.

The 12-week course is broken up into two sections: the 9-week didactic (lecture) portion and the 3-week clinical placement (hands-on learning). This format allows students to gain the philosophical and practical expertise to be a successful Pharmacy Technician

Students also receive as part of this program Soft-Skills/Work-Readiness training in collaboration with 716 Ministries. 716 Ministries pairs soft-skills training with one-on-one mentoring and coaching. Participants learn resume building, conflict resolution, time management, goal setting, budgeting, and successful interviewing skills. Each participant is paired with an experienced mentor who provides guidance and encouragement throughout the program and beyond.

Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will receive a certificate of completion from Trocaire College. If desired, the graduate is eligible to sit for the national examination offered through PTCB and upon passing, has the additional credentialing CPhT (PTCB) Certified Pharmacy Technician.
